Preparing for the Workshop:

Facilitator expectation	Student participation
<p>Begin a conversation about how important it is for a person to be interested in a career.</p> <p>Bring in to the discussion what would happen when interests change as a person grows and matures.</p> <p>If time permits, make an initial connection between goals, values, interests, and careers (a discussion that will be continued in detail at the end of the Interests Segment).</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have students give a list of things they are interested in doing
<p>Provide students with the following website to take a personality test.</p> <p>Inform them that upon completion of the test, they have the option of clicking on the Jung Career Indicator.
